By law (Section 59-1-425 of the South Carolina Code of Laws), districts are required to include at least three severe weather makeup days in each year's academic school calendar. We have included those three days (February 19, March 30, May 25) in this calendar. If the district does not need to use one of these severe weather makeup days, that day becomes a holiday. If the district has to delay the opening of school due to bad weather or other circumstances and that day is a collaborative planning day, the district will cancel all collaborative planning activities for that day.
