GHS students exhibit photography at Columbia Museum of Art

Gilbert, S.C.—Artwork by Gilbert High School photography students was chosen for exhibit in the Columbia Art Museum.

The student exhibit, *From Behind the Lens*, is in conjunction with the *Ansel Adams: Masterworks* exhibit opening at the museum Friday, Oct. 23.

The students' work showcases photography inspired by Adams, the renowned 20th century American photographer and conservationist famous for his landscapes.

Only student art from three high schools in South Carolina was chosen to participate in the exhibit. Gilbert is the only Midlands area school involved.

Both *Behind the Lens* and *Ansel Adams: Masterworks* will be on exhibit through January 17. CMA admission is \$10 for adults, \$5 for students. Admission is free on Sundays.
