The criteria to be considered for this scholarship are:

This scholarship is for any graduating senior at Lexington High School who plans to continue their education at any recognized two-year or four-year college or university in the State of South Carolina. The student must have a 2.0 grade point average.

General Rules

Applicants will be judged on financial need, character, achievement, and academics.

This is a "one time only" award and is not renewable.

This award will be presented at the school's annual Awards night.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the institution of the recipient's choosing.

How to Apply

Return the application to the LHS Counseling office by March 15, 2019 with the following attachments:

- The completed application
- An official academic transcript
- Two letters of recommendation—one from a teacher or high school counselor and one from a community member such as a pastor or employer (non-family member)
- A short essay (no more than one page) on what your future plans are and why you wish to be considered for this scholarship; and
- A short essay (no more than one page) on what "Living in the Land of the Free" means to you as an American Citizen.
