- Registered voter
- Resides in the Lexington School District One area
- Fills out Statement of Intention of Candidacy
- Completes Statement of Economic Interest and Campaign Disclosure online with the South Carolina Ethics Commission.

Filing closes for the Lexington County School District One Board of Trustees election.

- Canvass votes
- Certify results
