**The cost of the immunization is \$30 by cash or check or presentation of Medicare card.** The clinics are open to Lexington One staff, their families and members of the community.

This year the LMC Community Outreach Department is using pre-filled syringes of flu vaccine and not multi-dose vials. Due to the inoculation instructions, **we will be unable to vaccinate anyone who is: under 18 years of age, pregnant, or latex sensitive.** Lexington Medical Center Family Practices and our Pediatrics Practice would be happy to accommodate all children under the age of 18 and pregnant women.
