

Spring Cinquain



What is Cinquain?

A cinquain is a five line poem. It can be an effective way to practice *Parts of Speech* concepts! Follow this pattern:

- *Line One*: Decide on a one-word title. (**noun**)
- *Line Two*: Choose two words that describe your title. (**adjectives**)
- *Line Three*: Choose three words that tell about something that the topic can do. (**verbs**)
- *Line Four*: Choose a four-word phrase that describes a feeling about your title.
- *Line Five*: Think of one word that refers back to your title. (a **synonym**)

Here's an example of a cinquain:

*Penny
Round, Smooth
Tossing, Flipping,
Shining
Make A Special Wish
Lucky*
