BOARD RECAP — April 13, 2021 Meeting

On Tuesday, April 13, 2021, the Lexington County School District One Board of Trustees held a board meeting in the auditorium of Building One of Central Services located at 100 Tarrar Springs Road in Lexington, South Carolina. The board put some special safeguards into place to comply with the CDC's COVID-19 masking and social distancing recommendations.

The meeting opened at 6 p.m. in the auditorium. The board promptly voted to enter executive session to discuss employment recommendations for 2021–2022. The Board of Trustees resumed the public portion of its meeting at 7 p.m.
