

BOARD RECAP — May 4, 2021 Meeting

On Tuesday, May 4, 2021, the Lexington County School District One Board of Trustees held a board meeting in Building One of Central Services' auditorium located at 100 Tarrar Springs Road in Lexington, South Carolina. The board put some special safeguards into place to comply with the CDC's COVID-19 masking and social distancing recommendations.

The meeting opened at 6:30 p.m. in the auditorium. The board promptly voted to enter executive session to discuss employment recommendations for 2021–2022. This closed executive session took place in the auditorium. The Board of Trustees resumed the public portion of its meeting immediately after executive session at 6:50 p.m.

During the board meeting, the board approved:

- the May 4 Board Meeting agenda.
- 41 certified recommendations for the 2021–2022 school year.
- one administrator recommendation for the 2021–2022 school year.

During citizens' participation, the board heard:

- 63 people speak about masking at schools.

- a report regarding mask safety from Superintendent Gregory D. Little, Ed.D.
