The Arena does not allow items listed below to be brought in by patrons:

- Bullhorns, air horns or any noisemakers
- Tripods (Uni-pods only)
- Laptops
- Confetti or Stickers
- Concealed Firearms, Mace, Tasers or other weapons
- Fireworks or Explosives
- Backpacks or Large Bags/Purses
- Glass bottles or aluminum cans
- Ice chests (coolers) or thermos containers
- Laser pointers
- iPad's and Tablets
- Skateboards or roller blades
- Sticks or clubs (including sticks attached to signs)
- Stools or folding chairs
- Water bottles or mugs
- Posters or Banners
- Pompoms
- Flowers in a vase (wrapped only)
