What is Reading Recovery?

- One to one instruction
- Provided by a specially trained certified teacher
- Supplementary to good classroom teaching
- Short-term intervention (12-20 weeks)
- For the lowest-achieving first graders
- Ongoing professional development
- Long-term school commitment
- Lessons include the five essential components of reading instruction identified by the National Reading Panel: Phonics, Phonemic Awareness, Comprehension, Fluency, Vocabulary




















Text Level Change Fall 2020 to Spring 2021




Starting Text Level -Fall 2020




Winter 2020 Text Level (1st grade year)


SC Ready Performance of Reading Recovery Students



Student Growth - Reading Fall 2020- 1st grade




Fall 2021-2nd grade
